

Open Abal for Windows Installation

This document describes the installation of Open Abal for Windows.



1. An installation tool for **Open Abal** for **Windows** is available with the same syntax as for **LINUX**.
2. This installation tool can be downloaded from the **Open Abal** website:
<https://www.openabal.com/openabal-win11.exe>
3. It may need **the Open SSL** dynamic libraries to be able to work, and these may be downloaded from the **Open Abal** website:
<https://www.openabal.com/openssl.zip>
4. The contents of this **zip** file are to be placed in the same folder as the **installation program**.
5. The **installation program** may only be launched from the **Terminal Window**, in **Administration Mode**.
6. **The installation program** requires the following command line parameters:

--account <your account name>
--key <your api key>
--engine <the database engine name>
--hostname <the host name of the server>
--domain <the domain name of the server>
7. When you launch the installation, it will fetch the latest version of **Open Abal** for **Windows** from the **Open Abal** distribution servers.
8. The binary programs, libraries, fonts, images and style will be installed in the **abal64** folder under the folder where the installation tool was launched.
9. A basic Open Abal configuration will be recorded in the registry for the chosen database engine.
10. The installation procedure will be registered on the **Amenesik** website that manages the history of all **Open Abal** installations.
11. The installation parameters will be recorded in the registry to facilitate subsequent update operations.
